

Medicaid extends APS' contracts

The state Medicaid program has extended contracts for APS Healthcare to help manage the health conditions of about 250,000 Georgians. The contracts together are worth up to \$43 million a year.

Dr. Leon Haley, chief of emergency medicine for the Grady Health System, praised the state's collaboration with APS. "Our physicians, staff and patients work directly with APS health coaches," Haley said. "Through this interaction, the patients receive disease education, medication management and most importantly, alternatives for care when they are discharged from the hospital."
